

- Additional \$70+ million private investment adding over 300 apartments to the downtown.
 Scheduled completion is 2023/2024.

 Downtown employers include the Cabarrus County courthouse, government center, and sheriffs department. City of Concord offices and police department. Not to mention numerous professional and small businesses.



Concord is the county seat of Cabarrus County, which is now home to over 230,000 residents. The Concord area has led the way since the nearby discovery of gold, the founding of Cannon Mills, the Charlotte Motor Speedway and more.

In addition to the speedway, which hosts two major NASCAR events each year, Concord also boasts Concord Mills, the largest outlet in the state.

Concord can be accessed via I-85, US Hwy 29 and 49, and state hwy 73 and 601.

Downtown Concord is surrounded by a historic district that includes over 100 historically significant homes. This surrounding district and the vibrant downtown lends itself to a unique visitors experience, something that cannot be replicated in other communities.

There is a growing public and private art movement in Concord, making for the preservation of "ghost" signs to modern sculptures. Plus, downtown is host to numerous festivals, events and North Carolinas oldest Christmas parade.
